









- In each session, discuss with other small group (JBS squad) members
 what you have learned from your personal life and experience, and
 share your prayer requests. Then engage yourself in helping and
 praying for each other.
- Choose a medium (e.g. Facebook, Kakao talk, email) through which you can communicate with each other during the week.



- JBS Squad Meeting: Meet with your small group at least once a week to learn and share experiences with each other.
- A face-to-face offline meeting is recommended, but depending on circumstances, online meeting can be utilized (Skype, Google Hangout, Zoom, etc).
- Work on the group assignments together for each session, and then upload your assignments under "Group Assignment" on the JBS website.
