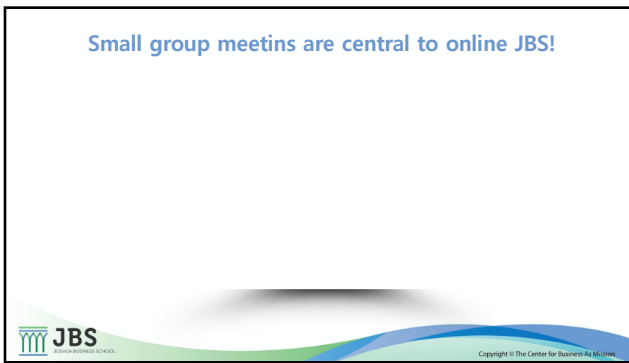
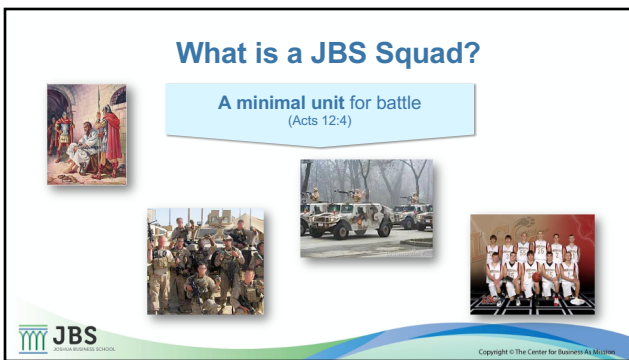

What is a JBS Squad?







A minimal unit for battle
(Acts 12:4)

Battle Squad:
Fighting spiritual warfare together in the business world!

Learning Squad:
Learning and practising the Word of God together!

Faith Squad:
Confession of weakness and sin, love and good deeds, and encouragement!








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JBS Squad Meetings



- **When and how often?:** at least once a week is recommended
- How long should a meeting last?
- **Method:** Offline and online (for example: Skype or Google Hangout)
- Choose a comfortable venue




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JBS Squad Meeting Guidelines

[Total duration 60-100 minutes]

- **Opening** (5-10 min): Praise and prayer
- **Session review** (5-10 min): Summarize core concepts and ideas of the topics of each session
- **Sharing** (15-20 min): Share personal understanding, experience, and application, etc.
- **Group discussions & assignments** (20-30 min): Work on group tasks assigned to each session
- **Scouting** (5-10 min): Explore the experiences of other squads
- **Prayer** (10-20 min): Share prayer requests and pray for each other





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Role Setting Within Squad Members

Set roles and share responsibilities within squad members!

Leader Coordinator

Plan and conduct meetings

Reviewer

Summarize core ideas of each lecture

Clerk

Organize meeting notes and submit group assignments

Others

Praise, pray, scouting, etc.

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Advice to JBS Squad Leaders

<p>Try not to teach but help each other to learn and grow together</p>	<p>Create an amicable and comfortable mood to encourage sincere and honest discussions</p>	<p>Keep group discussions within the particular topic and keep track of time</p>	<p>Provide opportunities for all team members to participate in group discussions</p>
<p>Assign various roles to team members and divide responsibilities evenly</p>	<p>Plan meetings ahead of time and reschedule when necessary</p>	<p>Be mindful of the preparations and participation of team members and pray for their growth and change</p>	<p>If necessary, closely engage group members to JBS lecturers or staff members</p>

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1 on 1 JBS


- Student and mentor becomes one group
- Mentor takes leader/coordinator role, and the student takes the remaining roles (reviewer or clerk)
- **Learning and growth of student is key**, mentors simply assist
- Student's **voluntary and active** participation is most important
